Three NHS Ambulance Staff Die in 5G Smart Grid Trial

Concerns have been raised after three East of England Ambulance Service staff members died suddenly in 11 days

On the 25th of September 2019 East of England Ambulance Service announced they were conducting tests on a 5G "smart" ambulance system.
Within 11 days of this trial was starting, 3 ambulance workers suddenly died.

Three staff members at the East of England Ambulance Service Trust have died suddenly in the last 11 days.

The news was confirmed by the Trust, who cover Hertfordshire, (Friday, November 22) but information surrounding the circumstances have not been released at this stage.

The <u>Trust</u> tweeted a statement confirming the recent deaths and outlining the support available to staff members and families.

Dr Tom Davis, EEAST Medical Director, said: "We are extremely sad about the deaths recently of three of our colleagues.

"We have extended our sympathies to their families and friends at this difficult time and we have provided immediate support to them and to our colleagues, including a helpline staffed by trained experts.
