Response;

Devon County Council can confirm that on the 9th of January 2019, the cabinet approved the [Street Lighting Policy](#). Please see item 288 on the link provided.

This agreed the continuation of installing LED lighting, to reduce energy and carbon consumption, and the provision of communication equipment on Lighting Columns. To date, however, the Street Lighting Team have not been approached by any telecom companies to install 5G on any columns.
